### AGRAGA - A New Chapter of Leadership Begins


### "Leader is the one who knows the way, goes the way, and shows the way"




A wonderful celebration of musical talent unfolded at Kikani, where students from Pre-KG to X were recognised for their skills on the keyboard and drums!



This insightful session encouraged our educators to create a more inclusive and supportive learning environment, empowering them to nurture future leaders and compassionate contributors to society.














### Empowering Communication through Learnscape Curriculum
